Academic

[Duke] Strong humanities and science departments. Classes are small, up to 15 students. Round table format. Faculty very accessible and helpful. Work load each night for freshmen is about 2-3 hours, sophomores, 3-4 hours, juniors and seniors 4-6.

College Counseling

[**Duke**] College admissions discussions begin early in sophomore year with PSAT testing and the college fair. Junior year, students are encouraged to sit in on information sessions from visiting colleges, assigned college advisors, begin SAT testing and preparation, and draft lists of potential colleges to consider and visit. There are only a few formal meetings with college advisors in the spring of junior year, but lots of informal communication. More formal meetings Senior year.

Admissions Process

[Duke] The SSAT is important. Interview required. Dress relatively conservatively.
