### Academic

**[Princeton]** Prepares you well for college. Very tough academic environment. The classes ranged from 4-15 students per class depending on the subject.

### College Counseling

**[Princeton]** The students are assigned their own college counselor beginning of their junior year. Counselor looks over your transcript and tells you areas that you may want to work on such as extracurriculars, sports, or community service.

**[Brown]** Begin focusing in on schools early in junior year with college counselor. The college counseling program at nobles is second to none, as seen with their matriculation list.

### Admissions Process

**[Princeton]** Nobles prides itself on accepting an eclectic mix of students who all have their own strengths. Thus in the application process DO NOT SOUND AVERAGE. Show them your special talent and demonstrate why they would want you at the school and the contributions you would make to the class.

**[Brown]** You must take the SSAT and being in the 90th percentile or above and it is much more important to be well rounded, and perhaps bring a unique characteristic to the school.

**[Princeton]** Extracurricular activities played a major role at Nobles since each student was required to do three (Fall, Winter, Spring) until their senior year. It forces children to find other passions and often forms new ones.
