### Academic

[U Penn] St. Albans offers great college preparatory experience. Mandatory athletics, moral teaching and a plethora of extra-curricular activities nurture a more dynamic personality.

### College Counseling

[U Penn] Begins junior year. Meet infrequently (every other month), but free to stop in and chat as often as you want.

### Admissions Process

[U Penn] Very selective. Perform well on the SSATs and the ISEEs. Extra-curricular activities in middle or elementary school such as book clubs, student government, and athletics have strong bearing. "Who you know" is an important factor. The interview is crucial.

### Extra-Curricular Activities

[U Penn] Strong tradition of athletic rivalries with The Landon School, Georgetown Prep, Episcopal, St. Stephens St. Agnes, and The Bullis School. St. Albans Government Club is a respectable and recognized group. A few years ago the Cultural Awareness Organization raised over \$20,000 in 5 dances to be sent to Red Cross efforts in Darfur.

### Quality of School Life

[U Penn] The dorm only represents 10% of the student population. It is a place where day students are welcome to hang out on weekends. Student body is diverse. The school is located in a majority black city. It resembles a typical prep school population. The faculty is of the same racial make-up. 80% white, 12% black, 8% Hispanic or Asian.
